A meeting of the Parish Council was held on Monday 6th March, 2023 in the Church Village Hall at 6.30pm.

Present - Cllrs. T.Hirst, S. Manzi, P.Wooton and J. Milne in the chair. The Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting.

1. Apologies - Cllrs.P.Evans, B. Perrett, P. Sandover and J.Brazil.
2. Declarations of Interest - Cllrs. Hirst, Manzi, Milne and Wooton - Agenda Item 9 - Planning application 0295/23/CLE.
3. Cllr. Brazil's Report - In his absence the Clerk reported Brown Bin collection for South Pool will commence on Thursday 16th March.

4. Public Participation - Silting-up of South Pool Creek - Cllr. Hirst reported a request from parishioners that Parish Council request the siting of a buoy or post to mark the channel to South Pool for future navigation purposes as the build-up of silt is going to increase over coming years. It was proposed by Cllr. Hirst, seconded by Cllr. Manzi to contact Harbour Board member Andrew Owen in the first instance requesting a buoy, passed unanimously.

4. Minutes - Minutes of meetings 09.01.23 & Planning meeting 31.01.23. were approved and signed.

5. Chairman's Report - Yesterday 5th March a plaque in memory of our long serving councillor and chairman Frank Green was blessed during the morning service. The plaque is hung on the wall by the screen.
